





# **STELLAR VISION Children who love** reading and have a strong foundation in the **English Language**


### What is a STELLAR lesson like?

1.Shared Reading Experiences

Children read storybook with the teacher and engage in oral discussions with teacher and peers

3. Language Use Activities in Learning Centres

The teacher prepares mini lessons based on specific needs of children to prepare them for reading & writing activities; e.g. grammar, vocabulary, word recognition, decoding skills, spelling

Experiences


The teacher models writing using children's language. Children engage in writing together and in writing independently



### **STELLAR needs Parents' Support**

- Home support to help children learn English by providing English language reading materials at home.
- Activate child's interest show your child that you believe learning English is both enjoyable and useful in your daily life.



### **STELLAR needs Parents' Support**

- Role models read and write notes and messages in front of your child.
- Understanding English language learning requires frequent exposure to listening, speaking, reading and writing opportunities and activities rather than use of worksheets alone.



# How you can help your child

- Allow your child to choose books to read and reread
- Read to and with your child (or, have your child read to you)
  - Remember that reading in a mother tongue language also fosters a love for books and knowledge
- Talk about the books and characters read



# How you can help your child

- Go to the library together
- Have lots of books, magazines and newspapers in your home
- Give your child books about their special interests
