



OVERVIEW OF ASSESSMENT


What is assessment?

Process of **gathering** and **analysing** evidence about students' learning to **enhance teaching** and **learning**.

Both **weighted** and **non-weighted assessments** are conducted to *check for understanding* and to *use the information to support students* in **achieving** the intended **learning outcomes**.

Teachers conduct assessments to find out what students **have learnt**, provide them with **feedback on learning gaps** and their **mastery of concepts**. Information from these assessments also serves to provide a **gauge of students' academic competencies** and **readiness** for the next level of education.

The difference is that the **score** from a weighted assessment **counts** towards a student's **overall result in a subject** for the semester or the year.

Primary 3 to 5

There will be NO Mid-Year Examinations (MYE) for Primary 3, 4 and 5 students. Weighted and non-weighted assessments will be conducted throughout the year and feedback on your child's progress will be given to you in the termly Holistic Development Profile.

Students will continue to sit for their **End-of-Year Exam (EYE)** for English, Mathematics, Science and Mother Tongue in Term 4. All weighted assessments will be reported in the Holistic Report Book in Term 2 and Term 4, providing you with feedback of her learning for Semester 1 and Semester 2.
